****COMMUNITY NOTICE****

The Royal Australian Air Force is conducting training activities from 15 April – 26 April 2023, in the Shire of Exmouth, Western Australia. Training will be conducted on a 24-hour basis during this period.

This training will see an increased military presence in the Exmouth area with activities being conducted on Commonwealth (Defence) land. Increased military patrols will be conducted during this period and penalties for trespassing in accordance with *Defence Act (Commonwealth) 1903* and *Crimes Act (Commonwealth) 1914* may apply.

Members of the community are reminded that access to Defence land is not permitted for your safety and the safety of Defence personnel involved in these training activities.

People should not be alarmed if they see increased military aircraft, vehicle and personnel movements. Training helps ensure the Royal Australian Air Force remains in a ready state of preparedness in the protection of Australia and its national interests.

The Department of Defence is unable to provide detailed information about these training activities, including specific timings, in order to protect operational tactics, techniques and procedures.
